

Green Chemistry and Sustainability Travel Scholarship



The Green Chemistry Initiative (GCI), in cooperation with GreenCentre Canada (GCC), is pleased to call for applications for this year's competition of the GCI symposium's travel scholarship which is a part of 100th Canadian Chemistry Conference and Exhibition (CSC 2017).

The purpose of these awards is to allow undergraduate students, graduate students, and post-doctoral fellows the chance to attend the 5th annual event held by the GCI – this year in the form of a Professional Development Workshop program which includes a green chemistry crash course, an industry case study held by GCC, and a career panel discussion, alongside a technical symposium as part of CSC 2017. The maximum value of each award is \$300 CAD to contribute towards travel and accommodation expenses. A maximum of five (5) travel scholarships will be awarded. No financial contribution from the supervisor is required.

DEADLINE

Applications must be received by **EXTENDED DEADLINE: Sunday April 16 2017, 11:59pm EDT** *via* **e-mail** to gcisymposium2017@gmail.com with the subject "Travel Scholarship Application."

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible applicants must be an undergraduate student, graduate student, or post-doctoral fellow.

- 1. Must attend the Green Chemistry Crash Course and Industry Case Study, and Career Discussion Panel and Coffee Mixer, hosted by the GCI, GCC, CSC, and the technical Symposium at the CSC 2017. You may register for this event by selecting the appropriate box when you register for the CSC2017 online (http://www.csc2017.ca/registration).
- 2. Must be presenting a poster or oral talk at any symposia of CSC2017.
- 3. Must acknowledge both the GCI and GCC in your presentation as funding sources.

REQUIREMENTS

All applications must include the following items:

- 1. A 300-word proposal written by the applicant which outlines the reasons for attendance in terms of the applicant's own professional development and a description of what sustainable chemistry means to you. Please attach it was a word document to the e-mail.
- 2. The CV of the applicant, including all publications and presentations (making the applicant's role in each one clear).
- 3. Estimated Expense Form (see below).

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP DECISION

Scholarship recipients will be decided by the Symposium Organizing Committee. Applicants will be notified whether or not their application was successful via email by **Monday April 17th**, **2017 at 5 pm EDT**. This was done to ensure applicants may still register during the Early-bird registration for the CSC2017, which ends Monday April 17th, 2017.

REIMBURSEMENT

For successful recipients of a travel scholarship, reimbursement of eligible expenses up to \$300 CAD will occur after the conference has ended. The cheque will be mailed to the recipients once all expense receipts are submitted by email to gcisymposium2017@gmail.com.
